



# Rounders England Minimum Deployment Guidance

Environment	Minimum Qualification required
<b>Primary School</b>	UKCC Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Rounders, Foundation Coach Award or 'Teaching Primary Rounders' award
<b>Secondary School</b>	UKCC Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Rounders, Foundation Coach Award or Secondary C4T award  <i>Important information</i> Coach should always support and not displace a qualified teacher
<b>Club/Team (Lead Coach)</b>	UKCC Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Rounders <b>or</b> the Foundation Coach Award  <i>Important information</i> Additional Considerations: 1:15 maximum ratio
<b>Community Environment</b>	Activator award, UKCCL1 in Rounders <b>or</b> the Foundation Coach Award  <i>Important information</i> Additional Considerations: 1:15 maximum ratio

In addition to qualifications, Rounders England recommend that all coaches who lead sessions should have the below in place:

- Minimum age 18 years
- Appropriate insurance to oversee the activity (Rounders England membership details available [here](#))
- Enhanced DBS check dated within the last 3 years
- First Aid Certificate awarded within the last 3 years
- Safeguarding Certificate (children or Adults) awarded within the last 3 years
